METHODOLOGY

SAMPLE N=1500 ADULTS BETWEEN AUGUST 3RD – 6TH , 2022 ONLINE.

THE MARGIN OF ERROR FOR A COMPARABLE PROBABILITY SURVEY IS +/- 2.53% 19 TIMES OUT OF 20.


THE DATA WERE WEIGHTED ACCORDING TO CENSUS DATA TO ENSURE THAT THE SAMPLE MATCHES CANADA'S POPULATION ACCORDING TO AGE, GENDER, AND REGION. TOTALS MAY NOT ADD UP TO 100 DUE TO ROUNDING.

KEY FINDINGS - SYNTHETICS

- 1. Canadians are acutely concerned about the amount of synthetic plastic fibers used in the modern fast fashion clothing industry (73%).
- 2. Vast majorities report being concerned about the role synthetic fibers play in:
 - polluting waterways & poisoning aquatic life (86%)
 - sitting in landfills for hundreds of years due to not biodegrading (83%)
- 3. As a result, most Canadian consumers want the use of synthetic fibers to either decrease or be phased out completely.



VAST MAJORITY OF CANADIANS WANT SYNTHETICS IN CLOTHING REDUCED






KEY FINDINGS – MINK FARMING & FUR

- 4. Canadians believe that natural fur specifically and animal-based fibers generally are more sustainable, socially responsible, and ethically sourced than their petroleum based synthetic alternatives.
- 5. Majority believe that fur use is a valid personal choice and believe government should not have a role in restricting its use.
- 6. Most Canadians have a positive (35%) or neutral (25%) impression of the mink farming sector in Canada. Very few oppose the sector (21%). The majority of Canadians (70%) who feel they know enough to have an opinion on the sector believe it:
 - supports rural communities (57%)
 - only uses abundant animals (56%)
 - is environmentally sustainable (54%)
 - take care to maintain animal health and welfare (52%)
 - follows humane farming practices (52%)




PUBLIC VIEW OF SYNTHETICS VS. NATURAL FIBERS/FUR


Wearing fur is a matter of personal choice




